AN ACT Relating to Boards of Assessment Review in Certain Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 30, § 2060, sub-§ 6, ¶ D, additional. Subsection 6 of section 2060 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph D to read as follows :

'D. Cities of 5,000 or more residents may by ordinance provide for a board of assessment review consisting of 5 or 7 members. The terms of office of members shall not exceed 5 years and initial appointments shall be such that the terms of office of no more than 2 members shall expire in any single year.'
