STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Benefit for Sheriffs and Full-Time Deputies under Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1092, sub-§ 3, amended. The first sentence of subsection 3 of section 1092 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Any participating local district, by filing with the board of trustees a duly certified copy of its action, may provide a retirement benefit for policemen and, firemen, sheriffs and full-time deputy sheriffs, in lieu of the retirement benefits otherwise provided in this chapter for these employees, of ½ salary after having completed 20 to 25 years of service, which benefit shall be based on the annual rate of salary being paid such individuals at point of retirement.'
