COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 250, L. D. 760, Bill, "An Act  
Prohibiting Obstruction of Discontinued Woods Roads."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§1580" and inserting in place thereof the following:

"§1580. Obstruction of discontinued woods roads prohibited

No person, unless authorized by the Forest Commissioner, shall  
obstruct any improved woods road or way used for the removal of  
forest growth, upon the discontinuance from use or abandonment of the  
same, if it may be reasonably utilized for preventing or suppressing  
forest fires. This provision shall not prohibit a landowner from his  
right to close or cause to be closed such woods roads or ways by chains  
or gates.

Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine  
of not more than \$500.' "
