## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Exempting Motor Vehicles of Forestry Department and Baxter State Park Authority from Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 256, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 256 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'All motor vehicles and trailers owned by the State and under the supervision of the State Highway Commission, the Forestry Department, Baxter State Park Authority or the State Police and all vehicles owned by a municipal fire department or an organized volunteer fire department shall be exempt from the provisions of this Title as to registration and payment of registration fees.'
