## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Funeral Expenses of Recipients of Aid to the Aged, Blind or Disabled.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 3409, amended. Section 3409 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 3409.** Funeral expenses. On the death of an active recipient of aid to the aged, blind or disabled, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding  $\frac{150}{225}$  shall be paid by the State if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare, the sum of \$37,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
