HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 579, L.D. 771, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Real Estate Law."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 3 a new section 3-A to read as follows:

"Sec. 3-A. R. S., T. 32, §4110, amended. The first sentence of section 4110 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The commission is authorized to require each applicant for a first-time broker's license or a first-time salesman's license or any applicant for a renewal of his broker's or salesman's license who has permitted his license to lapse for more than one year since the expiration of the last previous license—issued to him to appear in person at such time and place as the commission shall designate for that purpose for a written examination as to his qualifications to act as a broker or salesman and the commission shall collect a fee of \$35 in the case of a broker and \$30 in the case of a salesman.'
