## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Applications for School District Formation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 212, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 212 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

'It is the intent of the Legislature that all administrative units not in School Administrative Districts or operating high schools with more than 300 pupils in grades 9 through 12 shall submit plans for school district reorganization to the board at least once in each 2-year period until the process of reorganization is completed;'
