IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Driving Motor Vehicles to the Left on a Curve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1152, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1152 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'1. Grade or curve. When approaching the crest of a grade or upon a curve **or approaching a curve** in the highway where the driver's view is obstructed within such distance as to create a hazard in the event another vehicle might approach from the opposite direction;'
