## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relating to Time of Complaint Against Dangerous Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 7, § 3605, amended.** The first sentence of section 3605 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Whoever is assaulted by a dog when peaceably walking or riding or finds a dog strolling outside of the premises of its keeper and the said dog is not safely muzzled, may, within  $\pm 8$  hours 7 days thereafter, make written complaint before the District Court having jurisdiction, that he really believes and has reason to believe that said dog is dangerous and vicious.'
