## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Providing for Photographs on Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses and Identification Cards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 540, amended.** Section 540 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Each license shall bear thereon a photograph of the licensee, if under 21 years of age, which photograph shall be furnished by the State at the expense of the applicant. Any person, who is 21 years of age or older, who does not operate a motor vehicle may apply for an identification card with his photograph thereon, to be furnished by the State at the expense of the applicant.'
