IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing State Tax in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 451, amended. The first sentence of section 451 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'For necessary expenses of local and State Government, a tax is assessed annually at the rate of ~~11~~ 15 mills on the dollar upon each municipality, township and each lot and parcel of land not included in any township in the State.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is estimated that this Act will produce \$312,000 in additional revenue per year.
