**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Improvements at Indian Reservation at Pleasant Point.**

**Appropriation; for improvements at Indian Reservation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to the Department of Health and Welfare to provide improvements in water supply, disposal system and homes located at the Indian Reservation at Pleasant Point, Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Improvements at Pleasant Point Indian Reservation are needed as follows:

1. Plumbing and basic water to 5 family units	\$3,000
2. Septic tanks	6,000
3. Paint for 10 homes	1,000
