#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Granting World War I Bonus to Stanley D. Royles of Portland.

World War I bonus granted to Stanley D. Royles. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$100 to be paid to Stanley D. Royles, of Portland, as his World War I bonus.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Royles has never received his World War I bonus. He was born in Portland, July 12, 1898. He entered the service on April 2, 1917 and was honorably discharged August 11, 1917 with a Surgeon Certificate of Disability.
