AN ACT Increasing the Reimbursement of Towns for Snow Removal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1005, amended. The first paragraph of section 1005 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Towns, organized plantations and unincorporated townships, having a valuation of more than \$400,000 which clear state aid highways and town ways to the satisfaction of the commission and when necessary apply sand, gravel or other materials to a width of not less than 7 feet through the center of the road within a reasonable length of time after surface of the road becomes slippery, shall be reimbursed for the cost thereof to the extent of ~~\$65~~ \$100 per mile on the highways or town ways designated as provided in section 1002.'
