COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 264, L. D. 813, Bill, "An Act
Revising the Laws Relating to Disclosures of Debtors."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following
section:

"Sec. 1-A. R. S., T. 14, §1521, amended. The first 2 sentences
of section 1521 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes are amended to
read as follows:
'The judge or disclosure commissioner shall be entitled to a fee of
\$5 \$3 in all cases which are disposed of without a hearing. In all
other cases the judge or disclosure commissioner shall receive a
fee of \$10, and an additional fee of \$5 for every hour or fraction
thereof beyond the first hour spent in attendance at such hearing.
The petitioner shall be entitled to a fee of \$5 in every case
except those which are disposed of without a hearing.'"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th line
of section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In case the magistrate ~~who issued the summons~~ before whom
the debtor is summoned to attend is unable to'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 7th, 8th,
9th and 10th lines of section 9 and inserting in place thereof
the following: 'to serve civil process between the same parties.
Service shall be made in the manner provided for service of other
civil process ~~15~~ 7'
