AN ACT Relating to Office Hours for Registry of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 57, repealed and replaced. Section 57 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 57. Office hours. The registry of deeds in each county shall be kept open from 8 in the morning until 5 in the afternoon on every day, except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. Each registry of deeds shall be kept open on Saturday from 8 in the morning until 12 noon. All other county offices may in the discretion of the county commissioners of each county be closed in part or in whole on Saturdays.'
