**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officers of Waldo County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended.** The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'**Waldo County:** County commissioners, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,100; clerk of courts, ~~\$3,800~~ \$4,275; county attorney, \$4,000; county treasurer, ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,350; sheriff, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,400; register of deeds, ~~\$3,200~~ \$3,600; judge of probate, ~~\$3,000~~ \$3,600; register of probate, ~~\$3,200~~ \$3,600.'
