IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officers of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Waldo County: County commissioners, \$1,000; clerk of courts, \$3,800 \$4,275; county attorney, \$4,000; county treasurer, \$1,200 \$1,350; sheriff, \$4,000; \$4,000; register of deeds, \$3,200 \$3,600; judge of probate, \$3,200 \$3,600; register of probate, \$3,200
