STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Agricultural Societies to Qualify for Stipend.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 7, § 62, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 62 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '2. Minimum of \$800 on premiums. A society which pays a minimum of \$300 \$800 on premiums, exclusive of those for horse and ox pulling contests. In the event a society has not qualified for the Stipend Fund at least once in the 3 previous years, said society shall not qualify for the Stipend Fund until it has paid \$800 in premiums, exclusive of those for horse and ox pulling contests, for 3 consecutive years;'
