IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Maine's Share of Financing a Permanent Secretariat to the New England Governors' Conference.

Permanent Secretariat to the New England Governors' Conference. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$8,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for Maine's share of the cost of a permanent secretariat of the New England Governors' Conference.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At a meeting of the New England Governors in Boston, Massachusetts on January 25, 1965, the Governors of the several New England States approved a plan for the employment of a permanent secretariat to the New England Governors' Conference.

The above request is made in order that Maine may pay its proportionate cost of the functioning of the secretariat. The cost of this service will be divided equally among the 6 New England States.
