AN ACT Permitting Certain Corporations to Hold Stockholder Meetings Outside of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13. § 145, amended. The last sentence of section 145 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Corporations organized under the laws of this State may provide by their bylaws for the holding of meetings of their stockholders outside the State.'
