SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 626, L. D. 833, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Relatives' Financial Responsibility to Recipients
of Aid to the Aged, Blind or Disabled."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 7th, 8th and 9th
lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'An application shall ~~not~~ be ~~considered-unless~~ accompanied by
~~an-individual~~ a sworn statement ~~made-on-the-part~~ of the spouse, and
~~parents and-each-adult-child~~ of said applicant who is under the age
of 21 or is blind or permanently disabled, if residing in this
State and accessible. Such ~~statements~~ statement'
