AN ACT Permitting Sunday Hunting of Bobcats and Rabbits in Northern and Central Zones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2454, amended. Section 2454 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

‘Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it shall be lawful to hunt bobcats and rabbits on Sunday in the Northern and Central Zones specified in section 2353.’
