IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing Free Hunting and Fishing Licenses for Persons Over Seventy Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2301, sub-§ 5, additional. Section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 5, as follows:

'5. Licenses for persons over 70 years of age. A license to hunt or fish shall be issued without any charge or fee to any resident of Maine who is over 70 years of age.'
