AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Perch, Pickerel and Bass.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2552, sub-§ 7, additional. Section 2552 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 7, to read as follows:

'7. Perch, pickerel and bass. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there shall be an open season for perch, pickerel and bass in all lakes during the months of October and November.'
