STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Time Polls Must Remain Open on Election Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 741, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 741 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'2. Closing time fixed. The polls must be closed at $\neq 8$ p.m. on election day. The polls must remain open in each municipality until 8 p.m. unless each regisistered voter of the municipality has voted.

Α. Exceptions. In a municipality of 300 or less population, the municipal officers may determine the time for closing the polls, which must be closed not earlier than 5 p.m. nor later than 7 p.m. on election day In any municipality, the municipal officers may permit the polls to remain open till 9 p.m. on election day in a voting place which uses voting machines exclusively.'
