IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing a Mobile Unit for Registering Voters in Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 73, additional. Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 73, as follows:

‘§ 73. Mobile registration

The registrar may operate or cause to be operated a mobile registration unit for the registration and enrollment of the voters of the municipality at such times and places as he shall deem advisable, following the procedure outlined in sections 101 to 132.’
