STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exclusion of Certain Liens from Article 9 of Uniform Commercial Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., T. II, § 9-104, sub-§ (II), amended. Subsection (II) of section 9-104 of Title II of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

(11) To a transfer in whole or in part of any of the following: any claim arising out of tort; any deposit, savings, passbook or like account maintained with a bank, savings and loan association, credit union or like organization; or

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 11, § 9-104, sub-§ (12), additional. Section 9-104 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection (12), to read as follows:

'(12) To a lien reserved in a license to sever standing timber.'
