Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the period at the end the following underlined words providing the signature or signatures shall be legible.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S. T. 11, $\S9-404$, sub- $\S(2)$, amended. Subsection (2) of section 9-404 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes as amended to read as follows:

termination statement, he must note it in the index.
