HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 641, L.D. 866, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Procedure for Commitment to the State
Hospitals."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
new section:

"Sec. 3. R. S., T. 34, §2421, sub-§3, amended. Sub-
section 3 of section 2421 of Title 34 of the Revised
Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'3. Fees for transportation. In instances of in-
dorsement on the certificate of the licensed physicians by
the judge of probate, District Court Judge, Superior Court
Justice or by a complaint justice, under section 2332 or
2333, for the purpose of authorizing a health or police
officer to transport a patient to a state hospital, fees
for such transportation shall be charged in the first
instance to the department. Any fee so charged shall be
first approved in writing by the judge of probate, District
Court Judge, Superior Court Justice or by a complaint
justice. Reimbursement shall be sought for such expenditures
as in cases of expenses incurred in probate court commitment
proceedings.'"
