SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 557, L. D. 873, Bill, "An Act for Shrinkage Allowence on Motor Fuel for Service Stations."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "for Service Stations"

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 36, \$2906, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 2906 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'An allowance of not more than $\frac{1}{4\pi}$ from the amount of fuel received by the distributor, plus $\frac{1}{4\pi}$ on all transfers in vessels, tank cars or full tank truck loads by a distributor in the regular course of his business from one of his places of business to another within the State, may be allowed by the Tax Assessor to cover the loss through shrinkage, evaporation or handling sustained by the distributor. The total allowance for such losses shall not exceed of the receipts by such distributor and no further deduction shall be allowed unless the State Tax Assessor is satisfied on definite proof submitted to him that a further deduction should be allowed by him for a loss sustained through fire, accident or some unavoidable calamity.'"
