SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 557, L. D. 873, Bill, "An Act for Shrinkage Allowance on Motor Fuel for Service Stations."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "for Service Stations"

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, \$2906, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 2906 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'An allowance of not more than 1% 3/4% from the amount of fuel received by the distributor, plus 1% 3/4% on all transfers in vessles, tank cars or full tank truck loads by a distributor in the regular course of his business from one of his places of business to another within the State, may be allowed by the Tax Assessor to cover the loss through shrinkage, evaporation or such losses shall not exceed 2% $1\frac{1}{2\%}$ of the receipts by such distributor and no further deduction shall be allowed unless the State Tax Assessor is satisfied on definite proof submitted to him that a further deduction should be allowed by him for a loss sustained through fire, accident or some unavoidable calamity.'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
