IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Passengers in Front Seat of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 994-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 994-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 994-A. Number of passengers

There shall be no more than 3 persons in the front seat of a motor vehicle in motion, unless said front seat has been manufactured to accommodate more than 3 persons and there is at least 18 inches of seating capacity for each person.’
