**AN ACT Prohibiting Alien Contractors from Furnishing Board and Lodging
to Hunters.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T .12, § 2468, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2468 to read as follows :

‘§ 2468. Board and lodging to hunters

All alien contractors, who have their base of operation in the woods of Maine, are prohibited from furnishing board or lodging to hunters.’
