STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor by Social Clubs to Members of Same National and International Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 805, amended. Section 805 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'§ 805. Clubs; registers, sales to nonmembers

Every club shall keep and maintain a register which shall disclose the name, identity and address of each member of the club and shall be open for inspection at all reasonable times to any inspector or other authorized agent of the commission. Licensed clubs shall not sell liquor except to members and their guests accompanying them, except that vererans' and fraternal organizations and social clubs duly licensed may sell liquor to members of the same national or international organization and to members of auxiliaries of the same national or international organization and their guests accompanying them.'
