AN ACT Prohibiting Public Officials from Holding Liquor Licenses or Having Proprietary Interest.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 307, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 307, to read as follows:

‘§ 307. Public officials

No liquor license shall be issued to a person who is a holder of public office, either executive or elective, or who is a public employee, either national, state, county or municipal.

It shall be unlawful for any such person to have any interest in any such wholesale or retail business, directly or indirectly, either proprietary or by means of any loan, mortgage, or lien, or to participate in the profits of such business.’
