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**AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement of Members in Hazardous Employment  
in Department of Mental Health and Corrections.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 4, ¶ A, amended.** Paragraph A of subsection 4 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'A. Any member who ~~(1) Was a member on July 1, 1947 and~~ is the warden, the deputy warden, the captain of the guard, or a guard of the State Prison; or a warden in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, or a warden of the Department of Sea and Shores Fisheries; or the superintendent, assistant or deputy superintendent, a guard or corrections officer, of the reformatory for men or the reformatory for women; or ~~(2) is~~ an airplane pilot employed by the State of Maine; or a member of a fire or police department including the chiefs thereof and sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and, in any case, who has at least 25 years of creditable service in his respective capacity, may be retired on or after the attainment of age 55 on a service retirement allowance.'
