STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Personnel Status of Certain Employees in Department of Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 711, sub-§ 8, amended. Subsection 8 of section 711 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '8. University of Maine, etc. Officers and employees of the University of Maine, of the several state teachers' colleges and of the unorganized territory school system and the teachers and principals of the school systems in state vocational schools and state institutions and personnel of the Department of Education for whom teaching certificates are required by the State Board of Education.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, § 56, amended. The first 2 sentences of section 56 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'The board, in addition to other duties prescribed by law, shall select, subject to the Personnel Law, such personnel as may be needed for the efficient operation of the department, excepting personnel of the Department of Education for whom teaching certificates are required by the State Board of Education, who shall be selected by the board from nominations by the commissioner. Appointment of full time employees in the department shall be made by the board from nominations by the commissioner.'
