## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officers of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Somerset County, is amended to read as follows:

'Somerset County: County commissioners, \$1,000; chairman, \$1,200; clerk of courts, \$4,700 \$4,900; county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, \$2,100 \$2,200; sheriff, \$4,500 \$4,700; register of deeds, \$4,500 \$4,700; judge of probate, \$4,500 \$4,700; register of probate, \$4,500 \$4,700.'
