IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Signal Lights on Motor Vehicles of News Gathering Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1464, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1464, as follows:

'§ 1464. Signal lights for news gathering organizations authorized

An amber blinker or flashing amber signal light, not more than 5 inches in diameter, may be mounted on the roof of a motor vehicle owned by a bona fide news gathering organization and operated by an employee of such organization. Such light may be displayed but shall not be in operation except while such vehicle is en route to or is at the scene of an accident involving a motor vehicle.'
