AN ACT Relating to Temporary Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 29, § 533, amended. Section 533 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

‘§ 533. Temporary licenses

The Secretary of State may, in his discretion, issue a temporary driver's ~~per-~~
~~mit~~ **license** to an applicant who has successfully passed a complete examination,
or to an applicant who holds a valid or recently expired operator's license from
another state or country, permitting applicant to operate a motor vehicle during
a period not to exceed ~~30~~ **60** days while the Secretary of State is completing his
investigation and determination of all facts relative to such applicant's right to
receive an operator's license. The Secretary of State may, in his discretion,
issue a temporary driver's ~~permit~~ **license** to any ~~resident applicant~~ permitting
the operation of a motor vehicle during a period not to exceed ~~30~~ **60** days. Such
~~permit or~~ temporary license shall be in applicant's immediate possession at all
times while operating a motor vehicle.’
