STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to the Employment Security Commission and the Department of Education to Match Federal Funds Under Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the said 90-day period will not terminate until after beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to permit the State of Maine to continue programs under the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended, during the fiscal year beginning June 1, 1965; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Participation. In order to continue to participate in programs under the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2571-2620), the Maine Employment Security Commission and the State Department of Education, Bureau of Vocational Education, are each authorized to administer manpower development and training programs and to pay training allowances, to execute on behalf of this State agreements or contracts with the appropriate federal agencies containing such provisions as may be necessary or desirable to enable this State to participate in such programs, to expend all funds made available for the purpose of such programs by this State or local subdivisions thereof or by the Federal Government, to supervise the expenditure of such funds and the conduct of such programs by other public and private agencies in this State, and to make such reports and certifications as are called for, and otherwise to cooperate with the Federal Government and its departments and agencies in the administration of such programs.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated out of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of 478,000 to pay 33 1/3% of the costs of programs referred to in section 1 paid pursuant to the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended, with respect to weeks of training beginning after June 30, 1965, to individuals selected and referred for training.

Sec. 3. Fund. The sum appropriated shall be deposited in a fund, separate and apart from other public money or funds of the State. Withdrawals from this fund for costs of programs referred to in section 1 shall be made only under authority of the Chairman of the Maine Employment Security Commission or the Commissioner of Education, in accordance with the fiscal procedures established for the management and disbursement of funds advanced from the United States Treasury, for the payment of costs of programs pursuant to the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962, as amended.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
