AN ACT Relating to Operation of Certain Motor Vehicles for Profit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 35, § 1560, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 1560 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'B. While engaged, directly ~~or through a contractor~~ and exclusively in construction or maintenance work for any branch of the Government of the United States, or for any department of the State, or for any county, city, town or village.'

Sec. 2. Savings provision. Carriers operating within the Revised Statutes, Title 35, section 1560, subsection 1, paragraph B during the period between January 1, 1965 and the effective date of this Act shall be entitled as of right to a permit authorizing them to continue their operation, provided application therefor is made within 30 days from the effective date of this Act.
