## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Financial Assistance to Institutional Teachers in Obtaining Professional Credits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 1902, amended. The first paragraph of section 1902 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding before the last sentence the following:

'Whenever any certified teacher employed in a school program in an institution under the control of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections completes, within any 2-year period, 6 credit hours of additional professional work approved by the commissioner, such teacher shall receive supplementary financial assistance in the amount of \$50 from funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections for such purpose.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act and the breakdown shall be as follows:
