AN ACT Relating to Federal Receipts in Computing the Foundation Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3722, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 3722 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The average of the 2 preceding years' resident average daily membership of the pupils attending school in the unit shall be multiplied by the applicable dollar allowance in Table I below. To this amount shall be added the average of the unit's 2 preceding years' expenditure for tuition, pupil transportation and board. The total of these items will be the total foundation program. From this total foundation program shall be subtracted the average of the 2 preceding years' school maintenance incidental receipts, not including tuition receipts, **receipts from Public Law 874 for the education of "A" pupils, except those pupils that are attending schools on government property,** except that income received from a ministerial and school fund shall not be subtracted. The net cost thus obtained represents the net foundation program allowance on which state subsidy shall be computed biennially in accordance with this section.'
