AN ACT Relating to Definition of Disabled Under Aid to Dependents of Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 37, § 102, amended. Section 102 of Title 37 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Disabled under this subchapter shall also mean a person who has been judged as mentally ill or suffering from psychosis or neurosis to a degree which prevents him from earning a living.’
