STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Disabled Under Aid to the Disabled.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 22, § 3301, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 3301 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '4. Disabled. "Disabled' means a needy individual who is 18 years of age or older and who is permanently and totally disabled. "Disabled" also means a person who has been judged as mentally ill or suffering from psychosis or neurosis to a degree which prevents him from earning a living.'
