HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 788, L. D. 931, Bill, "An Act Relating to State Retirement Benefits for Certain Teachers."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by adding at the end before the period the following 'and Increasing Pensions for Certain Retired School Superintendents'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 1, the following:

"Sec. 1-A. R. S., T. 5, §1121, sub-§2, ¶ G, additional.
Subsection 2 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph G to read as follows:

'G. Paragraph C shall apply to all superintendents employed in any public school who have been retired under an order issued by the Governor and Council and are now receiving benefits, providing such benefits are less than those authorized by said paragraph C.' "
