**AN ACT Exempting Disabled Veterans and Persons Over 65 Years of Age
from Gas Tax.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 2911-A, additional. Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2911-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 2911-A. Refund of tax paid by persons over 65 or disabled veterans

Seven cents of the tax so paid upon such internal combustion engine fuel used by any person over age 65 or any disabled veteran in any motor vehicle owned or operated by him for his personal use shall be refunded.

The claimant shall present his claim to the State Tax Assessor in such form and with such information as the State Tax Assessor may prescribe accompanied by original invoices showing such purchases. Applications for refunds as provided must be filed with the State Tax Assessor within 9 months from the date of purchase.’
