IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Regular Deer Hunting After Deer Killed by Bow and Arrow.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2502, amended. The last 2 sentences of the first paragraph of section 2502 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'If a person does take a deer with bow and arrow during the special season provided in section 2501, he is precluded from further hunting for deer during that year. If a person does not take a deer with a bow and arrow during the special season provided in section 2501, he is not precluded from obtaining a hunting license for the regular open season he shall be able to take a deer in the regular season, upon proper licensing for the same.'
